Excellence in peer review: How to be an effective peer reviewer

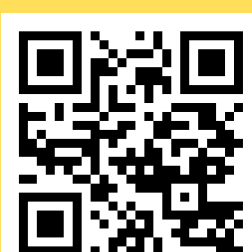
